## St. Eunan's Primary on going cashless

Clerical Assistant at St Eunan's Primary School, shared how going cashless with ParentPay made a difference to life at the school saying: "Having ParentPay implemented in our school has been a major plus for us, reducing the amount of admin resource needed for handling cash."
