

Northern Ireland school achieves cashless success The Diamond Primary School

- O Challenges faced by the school to process cash in a school environment.

Cashless school dinners

Principal at The Diamond Primary School in County Antrim, knows the challenges created by cash in a school environment. Even in a small school, tens of thousands of pounds will need processing by the school office, taking up precious resources.

The Diamond Primary School decided at first to focus on making school meals cashless. The Principal said: "We are saving 10-15 minutes a day, about an hour a week, per teacher. They were having to take the cash on a daily basis and mark the meal choices each morning in the class."

The teachers aren't the only members of staff who have experienced the benefit of ParentPay. The Principal also elaborated: "Meal management in the dining hall is much easier as catering staff can see who has ordered what meal and therefore they are confident that the right children get the right meal, reducing food wastage."
